- Moorea is Tahiti's sister island only 12 miles from Tahiti. It has mysterious volcanic peaked mountains and crystal clear lagoons.
- In an adventurous, open air 4 x 4 Safari vehicle, embark on a journey not soon to be forgotten.
- Climb the mountain to view the most magical awe inspiring view rightly named Magic Mountain.
- Proceed to learn about tropical plant specials and visit the ancient "Marae" A sacred sacrificial alter where tribunal decisions were made by the chief of the village and punishments were carried out.
- You will see pineapple plantations and stop at a tasting factory where they make fruit jams and jellies.

- In a comfortable 4 x 4, your adventure will take you through the green side of the sacred island, the caldera of the original volcano, pineapple and vanilla fields, While drinking from fresh coconuts you will enjoy stunning views of the mountains and the island of Huahine. You will learn about local plants, exotic fruits but also about the multi secular history of the Polynesian culture through the visit of the most important marae (sacred alter) of the pacific area.
- The Taputapuātea marae has been classified a UNESCO World Heritage Site– Taputapuātea on Ra’iātea Island is at the centre of the ‘Polynesian Triangle’, a vast portion of the Pacific Ocean, dotted with islands, and the last part of the globe to be settled by humans. The property includes two forested valleys, a portion of lagoon and coral reef and a strip of open ocean. At the heart of the property is the Taputapuātea marae complex, a political, ceremonial, and funerary centre. It is characterized by several marae, with different functions. Widespread in Polynesia, the marae were places where the world of the living intersected the world of the ancestors and the gods. Taputapuātea is an exceptional testimony to 1,000 years of mā'ohi civilization.

❖ **HUAHINE – 9<sup>TH</sup> NOV Morning departure. 4 x 4 Safari vehicle**

- Visit the town of Fare, Huahine's main town. Then proceed to the "Marae" (ancient sacrificial alter) and fish traps in the village of Maeva.
- See the vanilla plantation. Tahitian vanilla is the most sought after vanilla in the world.
- Visit of the Pearl Farm and discover the sacred blue-eyed eels in the Faie river.
- Stop at the Belvedere panoramic site
- Refreshment and tasting of island fruit.

- The Faarumai Waterfall: An enchanting short walk through a tropical rainforest to an impressive waterfall 300 ft. in the air.
- Blow Hole; An open in the side of the mountain which allows air to be forced out in an exciting blast. On the ocean side is the more conventional type blow hole where water shoots out in a huge blast. Both of these openings were created underneath the earth by lava flows over a million years ago.

- Illumination pearl experience come learn the pearl stories told When art and pearl instruments are one. Illumination offers include unique pieces made of Tahitian mother of pearl - designed, cut, polished and engraved to perfection by hand following Polynesian art and craftsmanship.
- The tour to finish off in a perfect relaxing way people watching outdoor dining enjoying a beer at the iconic 3 brasseries. For more than 22 years, it is the 1st Micro-Brewery in Polynesia producing on site craft beers, unfiltered and unpasteurized: The taste of the authentic! Installed since 1998 in Polynesia, the 6th generation currently perpetuates the family brewing tradition.

Please note: Although the off-road vehicle will remain on the main road for most of the drive, this tour also involves travel over non-paved roads with steep ascents and descents.
